With Fever Dreams, Maggessi/Morusiewicz present a new screening cycle dedicated to the Ursula Blickle Video Archiv. The duo focuses on the democratizing quality of the video format in the context of a public online archive. Inspired by Derrida's *Archive Fever* (1995), the series opens up a space for cross-generational dialogues: works from the 1980s and early 2000s from the archive alternate with contemporary filmic positions. This creates resonances between the different aesthetic strategies, socio-political contexts and dream-like realities.

ry and practice: inspired by Hiwa K's film *Pre-Image (Blind as the Mother Tongue)*, released in 2017, Maggessi/Morusiewicz shift attention to their own research process. In doing so, they link the Ursula Blickle Video Archive with media-based theory and their own artistic practice.
